THE NATIONAL PARKS AND NATURE RESERVES  
ORDINANCE, 1998

THE SIMILAJAU NATIONAL PARK (EXTENSION NO. 1) NOTIFICATION, 2000

(Made under section 20(1))

Pursuant to section 20(1) of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998 (Cap. 27), the Minister has made the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Similajau National Park Extension No. 1 Notification, 2000.
2. The area described in the Schedule and to be known as the Similajau National Park (Extension No. 1) is constituted as a National Park with effect from 17th February, 2000.
3. The Similajau Forest Reserve on which the Similajau National Park (Extension No. 1) is constituted, shall hereby cease to be a Forest Reserve.
4. The following acts shall be forbidden inside it and shall be subject to penalties provided under section 26 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998.

(1) No person other than a person acting under and in accordance with the permission of the Controller shall:

- (a) enter, reside or remain in the national park;
- (b) convey or possess any weapon, explosive, trap or poison or any contrivance of any kind used for the taking, capturing, hunting, killing or destroying of any animals.

- (c) kill, injure, capture or disturb any animal or take or destroy any plant, egg or nest;
- (d) cut or set fire to any vegetation or damage any object of geological, prehistorical, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
- (e) introduce any animal or permit any domestic animal to stray or introduce any plant;
- (f) remove any animal or plant whether alive or dead other than any animal or plant lawfully introduced by the person removing it;
- (g) remove any object of geological, prehistoric, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
- (h) destroy or deface any object whether animate or inanimate;
- (i) erect any building;
- (j) clear or break up any land;
- (k) prospect for or mine minerals, without prejudice to any rights lawfully acquired before 16th day of February, 1956; and the provisions of any law for the time being in force in Sarawak; and
- (l) place, dump, deposit, leave or throw any carcass, paper, boxes, bottles, tins, refuse of any kind, noxious liquid or other filthy matter of any kind in the said area.

#### SCHEDULE

Name : Similajau National Park (Extension No. 1).

Division : Bintulu.

District : Bintulu.

Area : 1,932 hectares approximately.

Boundary : Commencing from the estuary of Kuala Likau, the boundary follow the coastal line towards the southwest for 400 metres; thence it follows a cu lines bearing  $137^{\circ} 00'$  for 800 metres;  $229^{\circ} 00'$  for 2,000 metres;  $137^{\circ} 00'$  fo 2,600 metres;  $63^{\circ} 30'$  for 4,800 metres to meet Sg. Likau; thence the boundar follows the true right bank of Sg. Likau downstream for 5,400 metres to th point of commencement.

*Note:* Bearings and distances are approximate only and the demarcated boundaries and grid reference points shall be considered correct.
