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THE NATIONAL PARKS AND NATURE RESERVES ORDINANCE, 1998

THE TALANG-SATANG NATIONAL PARK NOTIFICATION, 1999

(Made under section 19)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998 (*Cap.* 27), the Minister, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, has made the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Talang-Satang National Park Notification, 1999.

2. The land described in the First Schedule shall with effect from 26th day of August, 1999, be constituted as National Park which is to be known as the Talang-Satang National Park.

3. The rights and privileges set out in the Second Schedule are admitted or found to have subsisted at the time of this Notification, and the exercise thereof shall be regulated by the Controller of National Parks and nature Reserves, and for this purpose, the Controller may issue direction or notice pertaining to the exercise of these rights and privileges.

*FIRST SCHEDULE*

- Name : Talang-Satang National Park.
- Division : Kuching.
- District : Lundu and Kuching.
- Area : 19,414 hectares approximately.
- Boundaries : This national park shall consist of two separate sections.
- Area I* : The Satang Area (approximately 9,894 hectares) shall consist of:
- (i) the area within a 4.8 km radius of the highest point of Pulau Satang Besar (approximately situated at 110° 9.7' East Longitude and 001° 47.1' North Latitude); and
  - (ii) the area within a 4.8 km radius of the highest point of Pulau Satang Kecil (approximately situated at 110° 9.7' East Longitude and 001° 45.6' North Latitude).
- Area II* : The Talang-Talang Area (approximately 9,520 hectares) shall consist of:
- (i) the area within a 4.8 km radius of the highest point of Pulau Talang-Talang Besar (approximately situated at 109° 46.4' East Longitude and 001° 55' North Latitude); and
  - (ii) the area within a 4.8 km radius of the highest point of Pulau Talang-Talang Kecil (approximately situated at 109° 45.8' East Longitude and 001° 53.8' North Latitude).

*Note:* Bearing and distances are approximate only and the demarcated boundaries shall be considered correct.

*SECOND SCHEDULE*

PART I

- (a) All land held under any issue document of title is excluded from the Talang-Satang National Park.

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2. beyond 2000 m radius of the highest point of Pulau Talang-Talang Kecil (approximately situated at 109° 45.8' East Longitude and 001° 53.8' East Latitude) and Pulau Satang Kecil (approximately situated at 110° 9.7' East Longitude and 001° 45.6' North Latitude);

Provided that no person shall carry out or participate in any activity other than those specified below:

- (a) Boating activities which:
- (i) are not in contravention of any written law relating to boating for the time being in force in Sarawak;
  - (ii) do not involve the killing, collection, disturbance or possession of any marine organism;
  - (iii) do not involve collection, disturbance or possession of any substrate;
  - (iv) are not in contravention of any regulations made under the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998; and
  - (v) are not in contravention of any provisions of the Wildlife Protection Ordinance, 1998, or any rules made thereunder.
- (b) Swimming or Diving activities which:
- (i) are not in contravention of any written law relating to swimming or diving for the time being in force in Sarawak;
  - (ii) do not involve the killing, collection, disturbance or possession of any marine organism;
  - (iii) do not involve collection, disturbance or possession of any substrate;
  - (iv) are not in contravention of any regulations made under the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998; and
  - (v) are not in contravention of any provisions of the Wildlife Protection Ordinance, 1998, or any rules made thereunder.
