THE NATIONAL PARKS AND NATURE RESERVES  
ORDINANCE, 1998

THE MIRI-SIBUTI CORAL REEFS NATIONAL PARK NOTIFICATION, 2007

(Made under section 19(1))

Pursuant to section 19(1) of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998[Cap. 27], the Minister of Planning and Resource Management has, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, made the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Miri-Sibuti Coral Reefs National Park Notification, 2007.

2. The area described in the Schedule shall with effect from 28th February, 2007, be constituted as a national park, which shall be known as the Miri-Sibuti Coral Reefs National Park.

3. The following acts shall be forbidden inside a national park as provided under section 26 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998[Cap. 27], and shall be subject to the penalties under section 32 of the said Ordinance:

No person, other than a person acting under and in accordance with the permission of the Controller, shall;

- (a) enter, reside or remain in a national park;
  - (b) convey or possess any weapon, explosive, trap or poison or any contrivance of any kind used for the taking, capturing, shooting, killing or destroying of any animals;
  - (c) kill, injure, capture or disturb any animal or take or destroy any plant, egg or nest;
  - (d) cut or set fire to any vegetation or damage any object of geological, prehistoric, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
  - (e) introduce any animal, or permit any domestic animal to stay or introduce any plant into a national park;

- (f) remove any animal or plant, whether alive or dead, other than any animal or plant lawfully introduced into a national park by the person removing it;
- (g) remove any object of geological prehistoric, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
- (h) destroy or deface any object, whether animate or inanimate;
- (i) prospect for or mine minerals, without prejudice to any rights lawfully acquired before 16th day of February, 1956; and the provisions of any law for the time being in force in Sarawak relating to mining;
- (j) place, dump, deposit, leave or throw any carcass, paper, boxes, bottles, tins, refuse of any kind, noxious liquid or other filthy matter of any kind in a national park.

## SCHEDULE

Name : Miri Sibuti Coral Reefs National Park.  
Division : Miri  
District : Miri and Sibuti.  
Area : 186930 hectares (water bodies).

Boundary : Commencing from a point (N04° 19' 02"; E113° 57' 29") on the coastal line [which is 380 metres North West from the Kampong Baluboh bridge]; thence the boundary follows bearing 306° 00' for 6200 metres; thence the bearing follows 294° 30' for 23200 metres; 212° 30' for 64000 metres; 180° for 8900 metres; 153° 00' for 12800 metres to meet Kuala Suai; thence follows the coastal line towards North Easterly for 79790 metres to meet the point of commencement.
