THE NATIONAL PARKS AND NATURE RESERVES ORDINANCE
FINAL PROCLAMATION TO CONSTITUTE TANJUNG DATU NATIONAL PARK
(Made under section 7(2))

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7(2) of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance (*Cap. 127*), I, Haji Mohd. Tazuddin bin Haji Junaidi, Resident of the Kuching Division, do hereby proclaim as follows:

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Tanjung Datu National Park Final

2. The land described in the First Schedule shall with effect from the 16th day of March, 1994, be constituted as a National Park, to be known as the Tanjung Datu National Park.
3. The rights admitted or privileges conceded within the Tanjung Datu National Park are specified in the Second Schedule.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Name : Tanjung Datu National Park
Division : Kuching
District : Lundu
Area : 1,379 hectares approximately
Boundary : Commencing at Tanjung Sarang (Grid Ref: OT 604274) the boundary follows a cut line due west at 270° 00" for a distance of 1,000 metres to a point on the international boundary; thence along the international boundary southwards for a distance of 5,500 metres; thence along a series of cut lines bearing 100° 00" for 1,140 metres, 60° 00" for 440 metres, 150° 00" for 100 metres, 60° 00" for 480 metres, 118° 00" for 360 metres, 39° 00" for 360 metres and 105° 30" for 200 metres to the coast of Tanjung Batu Mereka (Grid Ref: OT 610225); thence along straight lines out to the sea bearing 90° 00" for 1,000 metres to a point with Grid Ref: OT 620225; thence true north bearing 360° 00" for 2,390 metres to a point with Grid Ref: OT 620249; and thence along a straight line bearing 327° 30" for 2,950 metres to the point of commencement.

Note: Lot 143, Block 1 of Pueh Land District is excluded from the Tanjung Datu National Park.

N.B. Bearings and distances are approximate only and the demarcated boundaries on the ground shall be considered correct.

SECOND SCHEDULE

The rights admitted or privileges conceded within the Tanjung Datu National Park are that inhabitants of Kampung Telok Melano and Kampung Serabang shall be permitted to—

- (a) collect from the Park the following forest produce:
 - (i) damar;
 - (ii) rottan;
 - (iii) rubber, including jelutong, getah rian and malau;
 - (iv) pandan leaves, and leaves of other plants for basket making and weaving; and
 - (v) edible plants or parts thereof, including fruits, leaves and roots;
