THE NATIONAL PARKS AND NATURE RESERVES ORDINANCE, 1998  
THE ULU SEBUYAU NATIONAL PARK NOTIFICATION, 2010  
(Made under section 19)

Pursuant to section 19 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998 [*Cap. 27*], the Minister for Planning and Resource Management has, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, made the following Notification:

**Citation**

1. This Notification may be cited as the **Ulu Sebuyau National Park Notification, 2010.**

**Constitution of a national park**

2. The land described in the First Schedule shall with effect from 25th day of March, 2010, be constituted as a National Park which is to be known as the Ulu Sebuyau National Park.

**Prohibited activities**

3. Upon constitution of the National Park and pursuant to sections 21 and 26 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998 [*Cap. 27*], no person other than a person acting under and in accordance with the permission of the Controller, shall—

- (a) enter, reside or remain in the National Park;
- (b) convey into or possess any weapon, explosive, trap or poison or any contrivance of any kind used for the taking, capturing, shooting, killing or destroying of any animals in the National Park;
- (c) kill, injure, capture or disturb any animal or take or destroy any plant, egg or nest within the National Park;
- (d) cut or set fire to any vegetation or damage any object of geological, prehistorical, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest within the National Park;
- (e) introduce any animal or permit any domestic animal to stray or introduce any plant within the National Park;
- (f) remove from the National Park any animal or plant, whether alive or dead, other than any animal or plant lawfully introduced by the person removing it;
- (g) remove from the National Park any object of geological, prehistorical, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
- (h) destroy or deface any object, whether animate or inanimate in the National Park;
- (i) erect any building in the National Park;
- (j) clear or break up any land in the National Park;
- (k) prospect for mining of minerals without prejudice to any rights lawfully acquired before 16th February, 1956, and to the provisions of any law for the time being in force in Sarawak; and
- (l) place, dump, deposit, leave or throw any carcass, paper, boxes, bottles, tins, refuse of any kind, noxious liquid or other offensive or filthy matter of any kind in the National Park.

### Other prohibited activities

4. Other prohibited activities within that part of the National Park, which overlaps with the Sebuyau Water Catchment Area as published in *Swk. L. N. 49/2000*, shall include those activities stipulated in the Second Schedule to the *Swk.L. N. 49/2000*, except to the extent and subject to the conditions contained in that Second Schedule, or which do not comply with the orders or directions given or issued by the State Water Authority.

### Privileges of local inhabitants

5. Notwithstanding paragraphs 3 and 4, the inhabitants of the villages specified in the Second Schedule shall have the privileges to enter the National Park to collect minor forest produce such as leaves, rattan, roots, medicinal plants and taking fish using traditional fishing methods for their own consumption but not for sale or profit. The exercise of these privileges shall be regulated by the Controller who may issue direction or notice pertaining to the exercise of these privileges.

Name	: Ulu Sebuyau National Park.
Division	: Sri Aman and Samarahan.
District	: Sri Aman and Simunjan.
Area	: 18 287 hectares approximately.

Boundaries : Commencing from Global Positioning System (GPS) point (N 001° 28' 19.284"; E 110° 57' 46.835") which is approximately 556 metres to the east of the true right bank of Sungai Sebuyau, the boundary follows a series of cut lines bearings 149° 00' for 5569 metres; 184° 00' for 2200 metres; 237° 00' for 550 metres; 270° 00' for 8330 metres to meet Point 1 (N 001° 24' 21.679"; E 110° 54' 29.248"); thence follows the cut line in southerly direction bearing 180° 00' for 2203 metres to meet confluence of Sungai Maram and Sungai Kepayang; thence follows the true right bank of Sungai Kepayang for 4627 metres to meet Point 2 (N 001° 21' 35.221"; E 110° 55' 25.933"); the boundary follows a series of cut lines in easterly direction bearing 95° 00' for 2198 metres; 10° 00' for 382 metres; 83° 00' for 656 metres; 207° 00' for 550 metres; 95° 00' for 967 metres to meet the confluence of Sungai Ramin and Sungai Kedumpai; thence follows series of cut line bearing 109° 00' for 2295 metres; 79° 00' for 3205 metres; 70° 00' for 4435 metres to meet a confluence of an unnamed river and Sungai Sebuyau; the boundary follows the true left bank of Sungai Sebuyau downstream for 492 metres; 123° 00' for 1063 metres to meet Point 3 (N 001° 21' 59.905"; E 111° 03' 07.242"); thence follows a cut line bearing 187° 00' for 1895 metres to meet Sungai Sebuyau; the boundary follows the true right bank of Sungai Sebuyau for 3070 metres; 132° 00' for 1362 metres; 58° 00' for 139 metres; 129° 00' for 231 metres; 225° 00' for 56 metres; 131° 00' for 298 metres; 164° 00' for 2421 metres to meet Point 4 (N 001° 18' 36.753"; E 111° 05' 25.181"); the boundary thence follows a cut line bearing 109° 00' for 4125 metres to meet Point 5 (N 001° 18' 0.565"; E 111° 07' 6.576"); 216° 00' for 3612 metres to meet Point 6 (N 001° 16' 026.218"; E 111° 05' 56.477"); 95° 00' for 2940 metres to meet Sungai Menuang; it follows the true left bank of Sungai Menuang downstream for 3468 metres to meet Point 7 (N 001° 17' 05.84"; E 111° 08' 43.131"); it follows northwardly bearing 0° 00' for 4119 metres; 90° 00' for 100 metres; 35° 00' for 41 metres; 55° 00' for 94 metres; 90° 00' for 79 metres; 1° 00' for 1461 metres; 302° 00' for 267 metres; 15° 00' for 113 metres; 33° 00' for 147 metres; 56° 00' for 149 metres; 1° 00' for 624 metres; 326° 00' for 2141 metres; 290° 00' for 3947 metres; 294° 00' for 27 metres; 390° 00' for 4739 metres; 8° 00' for 266 metres; 295° 00' for 2101 metres; 301° 00' for 2675 metres; 318° 00' for 3604 metres; 329° 00' for 590 metres; 62° 00' for

359 metres; 330° 00' for 145 metres; 63° 00' for 94 metres; 329° 00' for 1775 metres; 60° 00' for 83 metres; 325° for 2297 metres; 256° 00' for 2833 metres to come back to the point of commencement.

Note: Bearings and distances are approximate only, and the demarcated boundaries and grid reference points shall be considered correct.
