THE NATIONAL PARKS AND NATURE RESERVES
ORDINANCE, 1998

THE DANAU MUJAN NATIONAL PARK NOTIFICATION, 2017

(Made under section 19)

In exercise of the power conferred by section 19 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998 [*Cap. 27*], the Minister for Urban Development and Natural Resources, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, has made the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Danau Mujan National Park Notification, 2017.

Constitution of a National Park

2. The land described in the First Schedule shall, with effect from the 22nd day of June, 2017, be constituted as a National Park which is to be known as the Danau Mujan National Park (in this Notification referred to as the "National Park").

Prohibited Activities

3. Subject to section 21 and 26 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1998 [*Cap. 27*], no person other than a person acting under and in accordance with the permission of the Controller, shall:

- (a) enter, reside or remain in the National Park;
- (b) convey or possess any weapon, explosive, trap or poison or any contrivance of any kind used for the taking, capturing, shooting, killing or destroying of any animals;
- (c) kill, injure, capture, or disturb any animal or take or destroy any plant, egg or nest;
- (d) cut or set fire to any vegetation or damage any object of geological, prehistorical, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
- (e) introduce any animal or permit any domestic animal to stray or introduce any plant;
- (f) remove any animal or plant whether dead or alive, other than any animal or plant lawfully introduced by the person removing it;
- (g) remove any object of geological, prehistorical, archaeological, historical or other scientific interest;
- (h) destroy or deface any object whether animate or inanimate;

- (i) erect any building in the National Park;
- (j) clear or break up any land in the National Park;
- (k) without prejudice to any rights lawfully acquired before 16th February 1956; and the provision of any law for the time being in force in Sarawak relating to mining, prospect for minerals in any National Park; and
- (l) place, dump, deposit, leave or throw any carcass, paper, boxes, bottles tins, refuse of any kind, noxious liquid or other filthy matter of any kind in the National Park.

Privileges of Local Inhabitants

4. Notwithstanding paragraph 3, the inhabitants or person of the villages mentioned in the *Second Schedule* shall have the privileges:

- (a) to enter the National Park.
- (b) to collect minor forest produce such as leaves, rattan, bamboo, roots medicinal plants for the own consumption but not for sale, profit, barter or trade;
- (c) to catch fish using traditional methods for their own consumption but not for sale, profit, barter or trade;
- (d) to hunt animats which are not listed as totally protected or protected animals under the Wild Life Protection Ordinance, 1998 [Cap. 26], for their own consumption but not sale, profit, barter or trade;
- (e) to cut trees for domestic use, such as for boat and coffin.

The exercise of these privileges shall be regulated by the Controller of National Parks and Nature Reserves, and for this purpose, the Controller may issue direction or notice pertaining to the exercise of these privileges.

Boundaries description :

Starting from point 1 (113°21'03.4"E, 2°55'41.9"N) at a confluence of Sungei (Sg.) Laing and its tributary the boundary proceeds along the true right bank of Sg.

Laing for 4,832 metres until point 2 ($113^{\circ}23'14.6''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}54'38.8''\text{N}$) at its confluence of Sg. Hulu Penyilam; thence it goes further down along the true right bank of Sg. Penyilam for 1,682 metres to reach point 3 ($113^{\circ}24'02.1''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}54'43.3''\text{N}$) at the tributary of Sg. Mirah; thence it proceeds upstream along the true left bank of Sg. Mirah for 4,215 metres to reach point 4 ($113^{\circ}23'36.2''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'42.9''\text{N}$) thence it proceeds along a series of straight lines in a generally westward direction at bearing $204^{\circ}08'11''$ for 707 metres to point 5 ($113^{\circ}23'15.3''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'52.4''\text{N}$) thence at $228^{\circ}19'34''$ for 1,403 metres to point 6 ($113^{\circ}22'41.3''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'22.1''\text{N}$) thence at $270^{\circ}50'33''$ for 540 metres to point 7 ($113^{\circ}22'23.8''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'22.4''\text{N}$) thence at $322^{\circ}53'45''$ for 776 metres to point 8 ($113^{\circ}22'08.7''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'42.5''\text{N}$) thence at $248^{\circ}11'45''$ for 478 metres to point 9 ($113^{\circ}21'54.5''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'36.2''\text{N}$) at the bank of the left tributary of Sg. Sirau; thence at $291^{\circ}13'08''$ for 1,120 metres to point 10 ($113^{\circ}21'20.7''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'49.5''\text{N}$); thence at $253^{\circ}16'14''$ for 717 metres to point 11 ($113^{\circ}20'58.5''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'42.8''\text{N}$); thence at $271^{\circ}04'33''$ for 845 metres to point 12 ($113^{\circ}20'31.1''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'43.3''\text{N}$); thence at $274^{\circ}25'35''$ for 1,091 metres to point 13 ($113^{\circ}19'55.9''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}52'46.2''\text{N}$); thence at $302^{\circ}03'34''$ for 890 metres to point 14 ($113^{\circ}19'31.5''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}53'01.7''\text{N}$); at a stream bank; thence at $332^{\circ}42'44''$ for 563 metres to point 15 ($113^{\circ}19'23.2''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}53'18.0''\text{N}$); at a stream bank; thence it proceeds along a series of straight lines in a generally eastward direction at $25^{\circ}27'05''$ for 822 metres to point 16 ($113^{\circ}19'34.6''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}53'42.1''\text{N}$); thence at $66^{\circ}02'16''$ for 547 metres to point 17 ($113^{\circ}19'50.8''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}53'49.3''\text{N}$); thence at $101^{\circ}56'39''$ for 633 metres to point 18 ($113^{\circ}20'10.9''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}53'45.0''\text{N}$); thence it proceeds along a series of straight lines in a generally northward direction at $350^{\circ}09'51''$ for 1,301 metres to point 19 ($113^{\circ}20'03.8''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}54'26.8''\text{N}$); at a stream bank; thence at $52^{\circ}13'49''$ for 642 metres to point 20 ($113^{\circ}20'20.2''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}54'39.5''\text{N}$); thence at $07^{\circ}02'31''$ for 442 metres to point 21 ($113^{\circ}20'22.6''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}54'53.8''\text{N}$); at a stream bank; thence at $349^{\circ}38'46''$ for 465 metres to point 22 ($113^{\circ}20'19.6''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}55'08.6''\text{N}$); thence at $11^{\circ}56'17''$ for 710 metres to point 23 ($113^{\circ}20'24.4''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}55'31.2''\text{N}$); thence at $56^{\circ}09'27''$ for 827 metres to point 24 ($113^{\circ}20'46.7''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}55'46.2''\text{N}$); thence at $02^{\circ}57'39''$ for 294 metres to point 25 ($113^{\circ}20'47.2''\text{E}$, $2^{\circ}55'55.7''\text{N}$); at the confluence of tributaries of Sg. Laing; thence following the true right bank at Sg. Laing for 722 metres to reach the point of commencement.

Note: Bearings and distances are approximate only and the demarcated boundaries and grid reference points shall be considered correct.
