THE SAMA JAYA (STUTONG) NATURE RESERVE NOTIFICATION, 2000

(Made under section 19)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the National Parks and Nature Reserves Ordinance, 1988 (*Cap.* 27), the Minister has, with the approval of Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, made the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Sama Jaya (Stutong) Nature Reserve Notification, 2000.
2. The land described in the Schedule shall with effect from 30th December, 1999 be constituted as a Nature Reserve which is to be known as the Sama Jaya (Stutong) Nature Reserve.
3. There is no rights or privileges admitted within the Sama Jaya (Stutong) Nature Reserve.

SCHEDULE

Name : Sama Jaya (Stutong) Nature Reserve.
Division : Kuching.
District : Muara Tebas Land District.
Area : 37.916 hectares.

Boundaries : The Sama Jaya Nature Reserve includes all those two (2) parcels of land within the existing Stutong Protected Forest (gazetted vide *Gazette* Notification No. 1034 dated 15th July, 1950) described as Lot 8177 and Lot 5554:

District : Limbang.
Area : 10,000 hectares (approximately).

Boundaries : Commencing at a GPS point which reads N003° 47' 23.83", E 115° 23' 42.66" at Sungai Tara on the existing boundary of Pulong Tau National Park, the boundary follows the true right bank of Sungai Tara downstream for 4,109 metres to meet its confluence with Sungai Kubaan; thence it follows the true right bank of Sungai Kubaan upstream for 651 metres to meet its confluence with Sungai Merang and Sungai Semirang; thence it follows the true right bank of Sungai Semirang upstream to its western source for 3664 metres; thence it crosses the ridge on a cut line bearing 341° 31' for 323 metres to meet an unnamed tributary of Sungai Limbang; thence it follows the river downstream for 867 metres to meet the right bank of Ulu Sungai Limbang; thence it follows the Ulu Sungai Limbang downstream 19,159 metres to meet its tributary with Sungai Tabun at N003° 55' 18.52", E 115° 21' 0.12"; thence it follows the right bank of Sungai Tabun upstream for 17,595 metres at; N003° 51' 15.89", E 115° 24' 25.37"; thence it follows a cut line bearing 161° 00' for 515 metres to meet an unnamed tributary of Ulu Sungai Limbang; thence it follows the river downstream for 861 metres to meet Ulu Sungai Limbang, thence the boundary proceeds in a southerly direction following the Batu Buli ridge for 5,994 metres to meet the present boundary of Pulong Tau National Park at a point N003° 48' 19.17", E 115° 26' 29.41"; thence it follows the boundary on a cut line bearing 223° 30' for 7,447 metres to come back to the point of commencement.

Note: Bearings and distances are approximate only and the demarcated boundaries and grid reference points shall be considered correct.
