THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION ORDINANCE, 1998

THE LANJAK ENTIMAU WILD LIFE SANCTUARY (EXTENSION I) NOTIFICATION, 2013

(Made under section 20)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Wild Life Protection Ordinance, 1998 [*Cap. 26*], the Minister for Resource Planning and Environment, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, has made the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Lanjak Entimau Wild Life Sanctuary (Extension I) Notification, 2013.

Constitution of a Wild Life Sanctuary

2. The land described in the First Schedule shall, with effect from 10th day of January, 2013, be constituted as Wild Life Sanctuary and known as the Lanjak Entimau Wild Life Sanctuary (Extension I) (in this Notification referred to as "the Wild Life Sanctuary").

Prohibited Activities

3. Subject to section 22 and 24 of the Wild Life Protection Ordinance, 1998 [*Cap. 26*], no person other than a person acting under and in accordance with the permission of the Controller, shall:

- (a) enter and remain in the Wild Life Sanctuary without the written permission of the Warden in charge thereof;
- (b) exercise and enjoy any right or privilege in the Wild Life Sanctuary, whether such right or privileges has been awarded any license, permit, or accrued or recognized under any written law, except in accordance with the written directive or guidelines issued by the Controller;
- (c) undertake any activities, studies or research in the Wild Life Sanctuary without the prior written permission of the Controller;
- (d) hunt, kill or capture, any animal;
- (e) keep or carry any weapon, contrivance or material of any kind used for the taking, shooting or killing of any animal;
- (f) be in possession of, or use, any form of trap, snares, net or other contrivance for trapping or snaring animals; the only exception are nets being used for fishing by people with subsisting rights or privileges;
- (g) cut, collect, remove or be in possession of any wild plant or any part thereof;

- (h) be in possession of any wild animal or any recognizable part or derivative thereof;
- (i) quarry stone, burn lime or charcoal, or search for, collect or remove any minerals, stone, or any other material;
- (j) erect any building or structure, or break up any land for cultivation or for any other purpose; and
- (k) kind or ignite any fire or leave a fire burning.

Privileges of local inhabitants

4. Notwithstanding *paragraph 3*, the inhabitants of the longhouses mentioned in the *Second Schedule* shall have the privileges to enter Area II of the Wild Life Sanctuary to collect minor forest produce such as leaves, rattan, roots, medicinal plants, and to fish using traditional traps and fishing methods for their own consumption, but not for sale or profit. The exercise of the privileges thereof shall be regulated by the Controller, who may issue direction or notice pertaining to the exercise of these privileges.

Boundary Descriptions:

Area II (9,641 hectares)

Commencing from a point (E 112° 16' 32.96"; N 01° 38' 40.51") at the river confluence of Sungai Katibas and Sungai Bloh, the boundary follows the true left bank of Sungai Katibas downstream for 1,263 meters; thence it crosses Sungai Katibas to the southern bank at a point (E 112° 15' 57.10"; N 01° 38' 18.56"); thence follows (the existing boundary of Lanjak Entimau Wild Life Sanctuary) cut line bearing 240° 00' 00" for 6,940 meters to reach Sungai Katibas at a point (E 112° 12' 44.89"; N 01° 36' 26.26"); thence follows a of cut line bearing 296° 30' 00" for 5,532 meters to reach a watershed which is the Julau/Kapit district boundary; thence follows this district boundary towards generally North-Easterly direction for 15,288 meters; thence follows Kanowit/Kapit district boundary towards generally Easterly direction for 15,186 meters; thence follows Sungai Nyeana Besai upstream for 3,036 meters; thence follows the forest edge in a generally Easterly direction for 2,430 meters; thence southerly 3,484 meters; thence westerly for 3,443 meters to meet Sungai Katibas; thence follows Sungai Katibas downstream for 1,190 meters to come back to the point of commencement.

Area III (4,584 hectares)

Commencing from the peak of Bukit Chondong, the boundary follows the watershed (which is also the Malaysia/Indonesia International Boundary) towards generally westerly for 4734 meters; thence follows a cut line bearing of 348° 30' for a distance of 6,739 meters to meet Sungai Bloh; thence follows Sungai Bloh upstream towards Easterly direction for 13,751 meters to meet the Malaysia/Indonesia International Boundary (which is watershed); thence follows this watershed towards generally south-westerly direction for 13,638 meters to meet the point of commencement.
