THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION ORDINANCE, 1998

THE SAMUNSAM WILD LIFE SANCTUARY (EXTENSION NO. 1)
NOTIFICATION, 2000

(Made under section 21)

Pursuant to section 21 of the Wild Life Protection Ordinance, 1998 (*Cap. 26*), the Minister has, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, made the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Samunsam Wild Life Sanctuary (Extension No. 1) Notification, 2000.
2. The area described in the Schedule and to be known as the Samunsam Wild Life Sanctuary (Extension No. 1) is constituted as a Wild Life Sanctuary with effect from 29th May, 2000.
3. That part of the Gunung Poi/Puih Forest Reserve on which the Samunsam Wild Life Sanctuary (Extension No. 1) is constituted, shall cease to be a Forest Reserve.
4. Upon the constitution of the area described in the Schedule as part of the Samunsam Wild Life Sanctuary—
 - (1) no person shall enter the Wild Life Sanctuary unless he first obtains a written permit from the Wild Life Warden in charge thereof;
 - (2) no person shall in the Wild Life Sanctuary—
 - (a) hunt, kill or capture any animal;

- (b) keep or carry any weapon, contrivance or material of any kind used for the taking, shooting or killing of any animal;
- (c) be in possession of, or use, any form of trap, snare, net or other contrivance for trapping or snaring animals, except the use of nets for fishing by people with subsisting rights or privileges;
- (d) cut, collect or remove or be in possession of any wild plant or part thereof;
- (e) be in possession of any wild animal or wild plant, or any recognizable part or derivative thereof;
- (f) quarry stone, burn lime or charcoal, or search for, collect or remove any minerals, stone, or any other material;
- (g) erect any building or structure, or break up any land for cultivation or for any other purpose; or
- (h) kindle, keep or carry any fire or leave fire burning.

5. Whoever does any act in contravention of paragraph 4 above shall be subject to the penalties prescribed in section 24 of the Wild Life Protection Ordinance, 1998.

SCHEDULE

Name : Samunsam Wild Life Sanctuary (Extension No. 1).
Division : Kuching.
District : Lundu.
Area : 16,706 hectares approximately.

Boundaries : Commencing at the confluence of Sungai Samunsam and Sg. Assam, the boundary follows the existing boundary of Samunsam Wild Life Sanctuary in a easterly direction with cut lines bearing $275^{\circ} 00'$ for 5400 metres; thence the boundary follows cut lines bearing $325^{\circ} 00'$ for 1550 metres to meet Sg. Bedaun; thence follows the true right bank of Sg. Bedaun downstream for 320 metres; thence the boundary follows a series of cut lines bearing $0^{\circ} 00'$ for 160 metres; $300^{\circ} 00'$ for 3416 metres; $15^{\circ} 00'$ for 1140 metres; $295^{\circ} 00'$ for 340 metres; $15^{\circ} 00'$ for 840 metres; $324^{\circ} 00'$ for 630 metres; $333^{\circ} 00'$ for 1350 metres; $70^{\circ} 00'$ for 396 metres; $22^{\circ} 00'$ for 800 metres; $293^{\circ} 00'$ for 405 metres; $23^{\circ} 00'$ for 1730 metres; $338^{\circ} 00'$ for 3360 metres; $29^{\circ} 00'$ for 560 metres to meet Gunung Puih; thence the boundary follows the International boundary for 29500 metres; thence the boundary follows the cut lines bearing $303^{\circ} 00'$ for 4240 metres to the point of commencement.
