THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION ORDINANCE, 1998

THE SIBUTI WILD LIFE SANCTUARY NOTIFICATION, 2000

(Made under section 21)

Pursuant to section 21 of the Wild Life Protection Ordinance, 1998 (*Cap. 26*), the Minister has, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, made the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Sibuti Wild Life Sanctuary Notification, 2000 and shall come into force on 29th May, 2000.

2. The areas described in the Schedule shall on the date of coming into force of the Notification be constituted a Wild Life Sanctuary which is to be known as the Sibuti Wild Life Sanctuary.

3. The said areas shall on the aforesaid date cease to be part of the Sibuti Mangrove Forest Reserve constituted vide *Gazette* Notification Nos. 777 and 920 dated 1.12.1930 and 11.7.1958.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE SIBUTI WILD LIFE SANCTUARY

Area A : Approximately 215 hectares.

Boundaries : Commencing at Kuala Sibuti, at a survey mark point No. 106 on the true right bank of Sungai Sibuti about 402 metres from its mouth. The boundary proceeds joining survey mark No. 105 in a south-westerly direction. Thence the boundary proceeds joining survey mark No. 104, No. 103, No. 102, No. 101 in a north-westerly, thence following the boundary of the Sibuti Mangrove Forest Reserve for a distance of 79 metres. Thence the boundary follows a cut line bearing $134^{\circ} 30'$ for 522 metres, bearing $44^{\circ} 30'$ for 278 metres to meet survey mark No. 8. Thence the boundary follows the survey mark for 150 metres in a south-easterly to direction survey point No. 9 and 140 metres to survey point No. 76. Thence the boundary follows the true right bank downstream for 4380 metres to the point of commencement.

Area B : Approximately 463 hectares.

Boundaries : Commencing at right bank of Sungai Sibuti with a bearing of $264^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 300 metres from the mouth of Sungai Piasu; thence the boundary follows the right bank of Sungai Sibuti downstream for a distance of approximately 4325 metres to the survey mark No. 34, thence following a cutline to north-easterly direction bearing $31^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 180 metres. Bearing $49^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 100 metres, bearing $319^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 200 metres, $47^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 1350 metres, $317^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 900 metres, $39^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 3100 metres and $152^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of about 1850 metres to the point of commencement.
